All wiring must be done in accordance with national and local electric codes. It is strongly recommended that you use a qualified electrician.</p> <p>Turn-off the electricity supply at the main circuit panel before installing. Do not connect the electricity supply until your lamp is fully assembled and installed.</p> <p>Place the lightbulb before mounting the luminaire.</p> <p>Fix the ceiling bracket to the ceiling by using mounting plugs and screws suitable to your ceiling type and take into account the weight of your luminaire.</p> <p>Determine the desired height of your luminaire and thread the wires through the extension pipes and the retaining nut. Place or hold the lamp in an elevated position in such a way that the wires can freely reach the ceiling junction box.</p> <p>Now slide the canopy over the ceiling bracket and thread the wire through the ceiling bracket. Connect the 3 power wires according to their colours. Brown is the live wire, blue is the neutral wire, green/yellow is the earth wire.</p> <p>Screw the retaining nut on the ceiling bracket and fix it as securely as possible.</p>

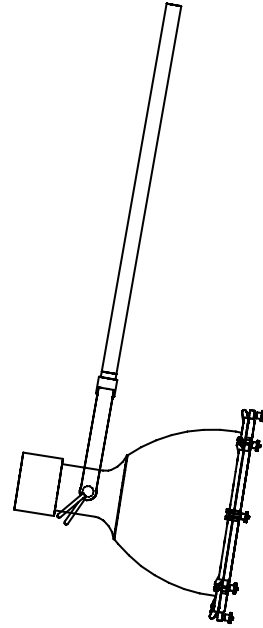
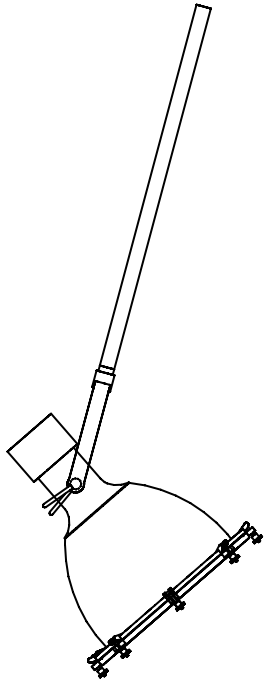

- 1 If you want the lamp to be fixed at an angle, instead of downwards. The pipe by which the lamp is attached to the ceiling will not remain vertical



- 2 Push the pipe gently and gradually to bring it back to the vertical position
